Notifications – A Recap

Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board issued 6 Notifications with Rc Nos. 39, 40, 41 and 42 / Rect. / Admn-1 / 2022 dated 25-04-2022 and Rc Nos. 45 and 48 / Rect. / Admn-1 / 2022, dated 28-04-2022 for Recruitment to 17, 291 Vacancies of various Posts in Police Department, Disaster Response & Fire Services Department, Prisons & Correctional Services Department, Special Protection Force Department, Transport Department and Prohibition & Excise Department - aggregating to **554** Vacancies of SCT SI Civil and / or equivalent, **33** Vacancies of SCT SI of Police (Info Tech & Commns Orgn) / SCT SI (PTO) / SCT ASI, Finger Print Bureau, **15644** Vacancies of SCT PC Civil and / or equivalent, **383** Vacancies of SCT Police Constable (Info Tech & Commns Orgn) / Driver / Mechanic, **63** Vacancies of Transport Constable and **614** Vacancies of Prohibition & Excise Department.

Scales of Pay (on appointment) of the aforementioned Posts are as follows –

Besides, there are several perquisites including Medical Treatment to the Employee and Dependent Family Members, Welfare Loans for House Building / Education of Children / Marriages of Children, Risk Allowances (up to 50-60% of Salary in High-Risk Units), Compensations for Job Related Injury / Damage, to which the Employees of Telangana State Government are entitled to.

Present Status

Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board has been accepting Applications in online mode in the prescribed proforma that has been made available on website (www.tslprb.in) from 8 a m on **2nd May 2022** onwards for Direct Recruitment to the Notified Posts.

There has been overwhelming response from the aspirants and in the past 11 days and at present (as of 4.30 pm), more than **4.5 Lakhs total Applications have already been received from nearly 2.5 Lakh Candidates**. Of these more than 1 Lakh Applications were received from Women Candidates (23%) and the rest from Men Candidates (77%). 6% of the Applications are received from OC Candidates, 53% from BC Candidates, 22% from SC Candidates and 19% from ST Candidates. Nearly $\frac{2}{3}$ rd of the Candidates have shown preference for Telugu as their medium of examination and $\frac{1}{3}$ rd opted for English while only 0.2% selected Urdu.

Advice to Aspirant Candidates

We would like to inform that the Applications will be received only in online mode precisely up to **10 p m on 20th May 2022** and this deadline for submission of Applications is final and shall not be extended in any circumstances. In view of the above, aspirant Candidates are advised to not wait till the last day to submit their applications and to finish the submission formalities forthwith. It would be pertinent to mention that if a very high number of Candidates try to submit their Applications in the last moment, they are likely to face certain overload related server issues. Hence, it is decidedly advisable to file the Applications, as early as possible in the remaining next 7 days.
